18 The Court having considered all matters contained in the court file  
19 and all evidence introduced at the January 29, 2010 hearing; and

20 Defendants Johnson having failed to comply with the permanent  
21 injunctive orders set forth in the July 7, 2009 Default Judgment including  
22 but not limited to converting and stealing Alcor's property and confidential  
23 materials, and having further failed to appear at their properly noticed  
24 January 25, 2010 deposition, to appear at the January 29, 2010 hearing in  
25 violation of this Court's Order to Show Cause, to comply with this Court's  
26 orders as set forth in its January 29, 2010 minute entry, and to cooperate  
27 in the rescheduling of their depositions,

1 NOW, THEREFORE IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND  
2 DECREED that Defendants Larry and Beverly Belletich Johnson are held  
3 in civil contempt of court. A warrant is hereby issued for their arrest and  
4 return to this court. That such warrant is, and is intended to be, honored  
5 under the Uniform Foreign Judgments Act as executable under the law of  
6 any state where they can be found;

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED bond shall be set for \$10,000.00;

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendants Johnson are once  
9 again ordered to fully comply with the July 7, 2009 Default Judgment, to  
10 fully comply with this Court's orders as set forth in its January 29, 2010  
11 minute entry, including providing Alcor's counsel with a letter from Mr.  
12 Johnson's physician on the physician's letterhead setting forth his  
13 diagnosis and the prognosis for when Mr. Johnson will be permitted to  
14 travel and/or participate in a deposition, not that he suffers from short-term  
15 memory loss;

16 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant Beverly Johnson submit  
17 to a deposition;

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in addition to the amounts awarded  
19 in the July 7, 2009 Default Judgment, monetary sanctions for attorneys'  
20 fees and costs are granted in Alcor's favor in the amount of \$ 34,107.00  
21 and against Defendants Johnson who are adjudged jointly and severally  
22 liable for same and that additional monetary sanctions of \$100 per day  
23 from this day forward are awarded in Alcor's favor and against Defendants  
24 Johnson for every day that they do not: (1) return to Alcor the original and  
25 all copies of all documents and other materials described in paragraph 2 of  
26 the July 7, 2009 Default Judgment and wrongfully converted by them; and  
27 (2) provide Alcor with copies of all written demands and authorizations

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1 which the Johnsons have sent to all third parties to whom Defendants  
2 Johnson provided any of the above documents (in order to achieve  
3 compliance with paragraph 3 of the July 7, 2009 Default Judgment).


